

Step 1 Assembly

- **1.1** Peel the plastic back from the sides and bottom of the windshield.
- **1.2** Per figure 1.2, position the windshield clips in the approximate center of the sides of the lower window. Use the rubber mallet to seat the clip within an 1/8" of the edge of the windshield.
- **1.3** Per figure 1.3, install both windshield latch clips on the bottom of the lower windshield, approximately 7" in from the sides. Seat fully with rubber mallet.

Step 2 Installation

- **2.1** Fold the upper windshield over and press the upper flange into the latch clips on the lower windshield
- **2.2** Per figure 2.2, position the windshield over the canopy front support tube structure and snap the latch clips and side clips over the tubing.
- 2.3 Unfold the upper windshield and use the rubber latches to secure to the canopy front support in the closed position.
 Note: If the top of the windshield contacts the canopy, push straight up on the front edge of the canopy near each corner. The holes in the canopy allow for a lot of adjustment between the supports and the canopy.

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
