### MODEL: KAWASAKI MULE 3000 DOOR KIT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

HARD SIDED DOOR (p/n KAF30-006 (RED)-007 (GREEN) & SOFT SIDED DOOR (p/n KAF30-008 (RED)-009 GREEN)

**NOTE:** If installing a door and rear panel kit at the same time as the cab, follow the cab instructions to install the rear panel. If cab is already completely installed follow these instructions.

## STEP 1: Installing the REAR WINDOW (Hard Sided Cab Only)

**A.** Remove the carriage bolt from the back of the **unitized side frame** installed to the **roof**. Save for later re-installation. Repeat on opposite side. (See fig A.)



**B.** Remove the two bolts from the **roof** back that are installed to the screen and cab bar. Save for later re-installation.



**C.** Remove the top nut from the seat back and loosen the bottom nut. Repeat on opposite side. Save the removed hardware for later reinstallation.



# STEP 1: Installing the REAR WINDOW (cont'd) (Hard Sided Cab Only)

**D.** Install 1/2" weather seal on the two inside metal strips of the rear screen.

**NOTE:** Clean surface before applying 1/2" weather seal. Apply at room temperature.



E. Install the rear window in-between screen and back of cab enclosure, sliding the rear window down with bulb rubber facing forward so that the cutouts go into the seatback brackets. (See fig E) NOTE: Be sure that the rear window is completely seated against the lower cross bar.

**F.** Re-install all removed hardware. Fasten all hardware securely.

**NOTE:** Be sure that the screen brackets are reinstalled inside the **roof**. (See fig F)



## STEP 2: Installing the REAR WINDOW (Soft Sided Cab Only)

**A.** Remove the top nut from the seat back and loosen the bottom nut. Repeat on opposite side. Save the removed hardware for later reinstallation.



**B.** Install bolt on **snaps** to the holes of the cab enclosure around the screen area, with the snaps facing inward. (**See fig B.**)



C. Install the rear window by snapping into place. Velcro the rear window to the cab bar. (See fig H.)

**NOTE:** Clean surface before applying **Velcro**. Apply at room temperature.

#### **STEP 3: INSTALLING DOORS**

**A.** Install the **outside rotary latch handle** to the **door (See fig A.)** using 6 mm x 12 mm long bolts, and 6 mm internal tooth lock washers

Install the **rotary latch handle (See fig A)** using 1/4"-20 x 1" bolts and 1/4"-20 nylon locknuts. **NOTE:** Leave **rotary latch handle** loose.

Install 1" **Heyco Plug** to the middle door stiffener over the rear handle bolt hole. The 1" **Heyco Plug** is included in the hardware kit.



- **B.** Install the **doors** to the cab by sliding the **hinge** sleeves on the **door** onto the **pin hinges** on the **unitized side frame**. Work the doors back and forth until the **hinge sleeves** are completely seated. Adjust **hinges** to align door with unitized side frame.
- C. Adjust **rotary door latch** and **striker** to compress the rubber seal all around the perimeter of the d**oor**. When adjustment is complete, re-tighten all hardware.

**D.** Install door stop cable (hard sided cab only) to the top of the door and the top of the unitized side frame (See fig D.) using 5/16"-18 x 3/4" bolts, 5/16" nylon locknuts, and 5/16" SAE flat washers, included in the hardware kit.

**NOTE:** Lubricate rotary latch and plunger often with spray lubricant.

NOTE: Re– tighten all bolts after 40 hours of operation and every 100 Hours thereafter.



