

KUBOTA L3800, L3901, and L2501 Backhoe Compatibility Kit p/n: 1KL38BCK Installation Instructions

A hard sided cab is shown. A soft rear curtain is used when backhoe compatibility is required on a hard sided (all steel) cab.

1. REAR CROSS BRACE

- 1.1 If a roof is already installed, temporarily remove the roof (with assistance).




Fig. 1.2 (view from right side of tractor)

- 1.2 Per fig. 1.2 (and with assistance), install the rear cross brace oriented so snaps for the rear curtain are inside the cab. Use the following hardware to attach the brace to the top rear of each side frame: one 5/16" x 3/4" long button head bolt, one plastic washer, and one locknut. The head of the bolt and the plastic sealing washer are to be on the outboard/rear side of the cab enclosure. Repeat for right side frame attachment then tighten both bolts.


2. REAR CURTAIN






Fig. 2.1 (view from right side of tractor)

- 2.1 Per fig. 2.1, engage the snaps on the rear curtain to the factory installed snaps on the rear cross brace.
- 2.2 Per fig. 2.2, the long left and right vertical sides of the rear curtain are to be Velcroed to the <u>inside</u> surface of the sheet metal. Note: for best adhesion, apply Velcro to surfaces that are clean, dry, and at room temperature.
- 2.3 If a roof was temporarily removed, re-install now.

3. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 3.1 Vinyl components should be washed with a mild solution of warm soapy water.
- 3.2 Clear vinyl can be easily scratched. Be careful cleaning frost or snow from rear curtain. Do not roll curtain in cold weather. The curtain becomes stiff and may crack. Keep curtain clean.
