BEFORE INSTALLING CANOPY

- Read all instructions and safety instructions in this manual.
- Refer to your machine's operator's manual and safety instructions on your machine's safety decals.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when performing work.
- Hang a "DO NOT OPERATE" tag in operator station.
- If installing windshield and/or rear panel, install those components before installing canopy.
- If installing work lights, it will ease assembly if they are installed prior to installing canopy onto vehicle.



WARNING



ASSEMBLY PROCEDURE


• All assembly procedures listed within this manual are generally representative of the machine model for which the manual is written. Your machine may be configured differently, but the outline for the procedure should still be followed. For further support for any issues not covered within the pages of this manual, please contact your local Kubota representative.

1. Remove 2 front right ROPS bolts (M10), and save for re-use.

2. Install right canopy mount, using ROPS bolts removed in step 1. Torque to 38 ft.-lbs. (See fig. 2)

- 3. Repeat on left side.
- 4. Cut the provided foam tape in half.

5. Install foam tape to the top of the front-to-rear ROPS tubes on both sides of the vehicle. Foam tape to start approximately 1-1/2" in front of front ROPS bracket edge. (See fig. 5) Note: For best adhesion, apply to a clean, dry surface at room temperature.








IMPORTANT! If installing a windshield and/ or rear panel, proceed to installing those components prior to completing canopy installation.

6. Remove (2) top rear ROPS bolts (M10). Discard. 7. Loosely install (2) P-Clamps onto ROPS rear cross member at both bends in approximate location shown. Orient flat section up. Fasteners to be installed later. 8. Align mounting holes in canopy to rear ROPS mounting holes, P-Clamps, and slots in canopy mounts. 9. Install M10 x 30mm long screws, with 3/8" ID fender washers, 5/8" ID rubber washers, and steel spacers provided. See Fastener Installation Diagram 1 for fastener installation order. Torque to 38 ft.-lbs. 10. Install (4) 5/16-18 screws, washers, etc. through front canopy mounting holes. (see fig. 10) See Fastener Installation Diagram 2 for fastener installation order. Note: (2) inner front fasteners will be used solely to plug the mounting holes if no windshield is installed. 11. Install (2) 5/16-18 screws and washers through canopy and P-Clamps in rear. Secure with 5/16-18 flange nut. See Fastener Installation Diagram 2 for fastener installation order.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Check and tighten hardware after 20 hours of operation.

Periodically inspect and tighten hardware for the remainder of the unit's service life.

IMPORTANT CLEANING INFORMATION

Keep the enclosure components clean in order to prevent dust and dirt from forming an unattractive film. The life of your canopy depends upon following these care procedures:

12. **NEVER USE** AN ABRASIVE DETERGENT / VEHICLE CLEANER OR A WIRE BRISTLED BRUSH. Do not use any **CITRUS BASED CLEANERS** such as orange or lemon. Use of these products will cause the plastic to become permanently damaged.

13. Clean the plastic enclosure surfaces thoroughly with warm soapy water and a COTTON cloth or chamois. Be sure to use mild soap, specifically a dish liquid or equivalent. Clean in a light circular motion for best results.

14. Use EXTRA CAUTION when cleaning the interior of the enclosure. The interior is more sensitive than the exterior because the exterior has an extra coating for U.V. stability.

15. Remove grease and oil with mineral spirits and a COTTON cloth or chamois.
