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STEP 1: (KIT INSTALLATION)

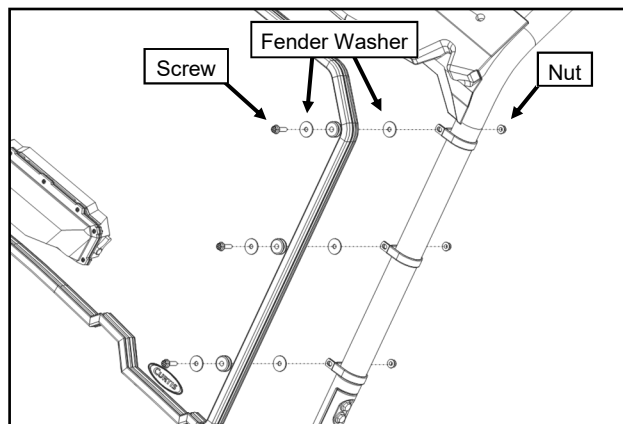


Fig. 1.4 (Windshield Hardware)

1.4 Secure the windshield assembly to the P-clamps installed during steps 1.1 & 1.2. See figure 1.4 for hardware orientation. Do not overtighten fastener or damage to the window may occur. Stop tightening when grommet just starts to bulge.

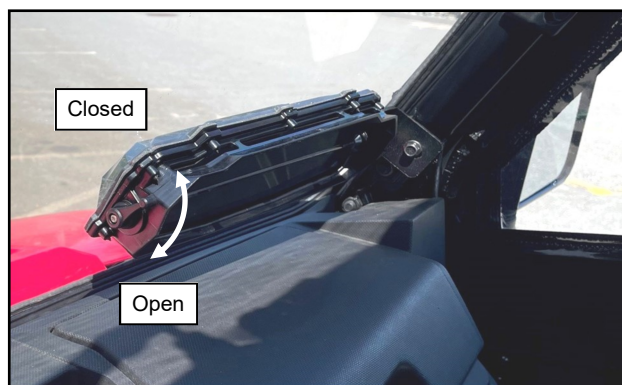

WINDSHIELD VENTS

For ventilation, a vent has been provided in this windshield.

To Operate Vent:

- 1) Rotate vent lever away from the windshield to open and towards the windshield to close.
- 2) It can be opened partially to allow air to flow up the inside surface of the windshield to clear fog.



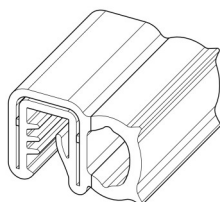

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

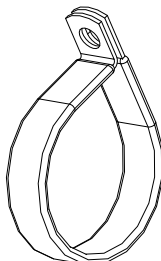
- Check and tighten hardware after 40 hours of operation. Periodically inspect and tighten hardware for the remainder of the unit's life.
- **DO NOT** clean polycarbonate windows with harsh chemicals. It will damage the plastic. Mild soap and water should be used on the windshield.
