STEP 1: (KIT INSTALLATION)

If installing multiple Curtis Polaris RZR 1000 kits, install in the following order:

- 1. Windshield
- 2. Rear Panel
- 3. Roof




Fig. 1.1 (P-Clamp Orientation)

- 1.1 Per figure 1.1, position the (7) supplied rubber coated P-clamps around the rear portion of the ROPS.
- **1.2** With assistance, position the rear panel assembly to the front side of the rear portion of the ROPS.

KIT INSTALLATION

STEP 1: (KIT INSTALLATION)




Fig. 1.3 (Rear Panel Hardware)

1.3 Secure the rear panel assembly to the P-clamps installed during step 1.1. See figure 1.3 for hardware orientation. Do not overtighten fastener or damage to the window may occur. Stop tightening when grommet just starts to bulge.

1/4-20 X 1" Flange Hex Head Screw	7
1/4" Fender Washer	14
1/4-20 Hex Flange Lock Nut	7

3/8" socket or wrench
7/16" socket or wrench

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Check and tighten hardware after 40 hours of operation. Periodically inspect and tighten hardware for the remainder of the unit's life.
- **DO NOT** clean polycarbonate windows with harsh chemicals. It will damage the plastic. Mild soap and water should be used on the rear panel.
